FA CUP NEWS ROUND-UP

The Adobe Women's FA Cup Second Round Proper draw will be made tomorrow (Monday) evening, live on the official TNT Sports YouTube channel.

Taking place from 7pm at a venue to be confirmed following the completion of today's First Round ties, the draw will be presented by Flo Lloyd-Hughes and made by Mollie Kmita, Rosie Kmita and Gilly Flaherty.

Further details will be released, as well as the ball numbers, tomorrow morning.

Ahead of the Emirates FA Cup and Adobe Women's FA Cup First Round Proper, Mitre has unveiled the official match balls for their 2025-26 editions.

FA CUP HISTORY: ARSENAL HOLD RECORD FOR MOST WINS

The Women's FA Cup is the premier knock-out competition in England, which was first founded in 1970, initially as the WFA Cup.

It has since been known as the FA Women's Cup and has attracted sponsorship from UK Living, Nationwide, AXA, E.ON and Vitality over the years and is currently the Adobe Women's FA Cup.

In its early days, the competition was knows as the Mitre Challenge Trophy and was organised by the Women's Football Association (WFA).

The competition also included teams from Scotland and Wales, with the first three finals featuring teams from north of the border.

The WFA ran the competition for the first 23 editions, during which time Southampton won the cup eight times in its first 11 campaigns.

The FA began administering English women's football in mid-1993.

Arsenal currently hold the record for most titles overall, having won the cup 14 times.

The current holders are Chelsea, who defeated Manchester United 3-0 in the 2025 final.
