BRAVE SCARLETT SHOWS WHY EYE TESTS ARE SO CRUCIAL

Scarlett Billingham will be one of the mascots proudly leading out the AFC Portchester team before today's game.

The brave youngster has recently had surgery to remove a brain tumour which was discovered while she was having her annual eye check up.

Now Scarlett and her family want to make people aware of the importance of children having regular eye tests and raise much needed funds for charities directly involved in research and treatment of brain tumours.

Scarlett's father Tom said: "Scarlett went for a routine eye test, something we do every year for our girls. During the appointment the optician found swelling behind both optic nerves.

"This led to urgent hospital scans and within days Scarlett was diagnosed with a brain tumour.

She was fit, active and doing well at school with no signs that anything was wrong. The diagnosis came as a complete shock.

"The only reason this tumour was discovered early was because of that simple eye test. We want other families to know that these checks can make all the difference.

"We have set up a JustGiving page to raise awareness of how important eye tests are

for children and to support the charities that help families during frightening and uncertain moments like these."

Scarlett has had surgery to remove the tumour and Tom added: "She is recovering well and we remain grateful for the kindness and professionalism shown by everyone who has supported her."

ÄFC Portchester's players have been sending Scarlett good luck messages and have made donations to the fundraising effort, which has a target of £12,000.

The majority of the funds will be donated to three charities which have a direct connection to what families face in these situations – Ronald McDonald House Charities, Brain Tumour Research and Southampton Hospital Charity for paediatric neurology.

A small portion of the funds will be used to rebook a short family holiday for Scarlett. The family had to cancel their break just hours before they were due to travel so Scarlett could undergo urgent neurosurgery.

BATH LOOKING TO ADD TO HER GOAL TALLY IN COMPETITION

She has already fired home nine goals this season in the Adobe Women's FA Cup – and AFC Portchester's joint top goalscorer Becki Bath is hungry for more.

The ex-Worthing player goes up against her former club in the Second Round tie in a rich vein of goalscoring form in the competition.

She netted six goals in the 19-0 win over Weymouth and then another hat-trick of strikes in the 6-2 victory over Gloucester City in the previous round.

Add two more to that tally and she has already scored 11 times for the Royals this season.

Bath is looking forward to the challenge playing Worthing at The OnSite Group Stadium will pose for both herself and the team.

"This game will be a great test for us and an opportunity to show the determination and

character we have within the team," explained Becki.

"I can't wait for the challenge ahead in Sunday's game – hopefully it's another opportunity for myself to get on the score sheet.

"Within the team the vibes are great. We are all looking forward to hopefully progressing in the FA Cup and getting the chance to show what level we are able to play at."

Bath will be looking to use her experience to guide the Royals through to the Third Round – which would be the furthest point the club has ever reached in the competition.

She signed for Worthing in the summer of 2023 after previously being at AFC Wimbledon. Her impressive list of other former clubs includes Moneyfields, Southampton Saints, Portsmouth and AFC Bournemouth.



HALL OF FAME STAR LOOKING TO MAKE HISTORY FOR ROYALS

She has already made it into one hall of fame but Gemma Hillier could write herself into the AFC Portchester history books as well if she leads her side into the Third Round of the Adobe Women's FA Cup.

Hillier became the first female player to be inducted into Pompey's Hall of Fame in 2018, joining the likes of Portsmouth greats Jimmy Dickinson, Paul Merson, Alan Knight and Mark Hateley to be given the honour.

Hillier made 282 appearances for Portsmouth's ladies team, scoring 92 goals and she spent 17 years at the club.

She went on to play for AFC Bournemouth and captained the side when the Cherries reached the Third Round of the Women's FA Cup for the first time in their history.

Now the Royals' captain is aiming to create another piece of history in the women's game by helping to guide the Royals into the Third Round for the very first time. "We're really proud to have reached the second round proper for the second season running, equalling our best ever achievement," said Gemma.

"We head into Sunday's game against Worthing on the back of a six-match winning streak, and the squad is in a great place."

AFC Portchester ladies have hit their top form in recent weeks after some changes during the close season and Hillier believes the Royals go into their FA Cup tie in the best possible shape.

She added: "With so many new signings it's taken time to gel, but the team spirit and togetherness we are showing now is fantastic.

"Every player has had valuable minutes in recent weeks, which puts us in a strong position to compete.

"Worthing are in the league above us, but we're determined to make it tough for them and show exactly what AFC Portchester are capable of."

FA CUP DRAW NEWS

There will be £35,000 for winning clubs and £9,000 for the losing teams from this season's prize fund in the Third Round of the competition.

The draw was presented by Flo Lloyd-Hughes, Mollie Kmita and Rosie Kmita, who were joined by former England international and Women's FA Cup winner Carly Telford to make the draw live on the official Adobe Women's FA Cup, TNT Sports and Channel 4 YouTube channels.

The draw took place last Monday and means that the winners of today's game between AFC Portchester and Worthing will be at home to Ipswich Town in the next round.


