I would like to extend a warm welcome to the committee, management, players and volunteers from Reigate travelling across Surrey to us for tonight's game. We hope you enjoy your visit.



REIGATE PRIORY

Reigate Priory's history can be traced right back to 1870, not long after the FA was actually formed in 1863.

In 1871, the club was one of only 15 teams that contested for a £20 silver trophy, the first ever FA Challenge Cup competition. Reigate Priory were also present when the Surrey FA (founded in 1887) decided to become affiliated to the FA on March 16th 1882. The club was one of the original 10 teams present at the meeting that took place in Guildford.

At the same time a County Senior Cup competition introduced. The first winners of the Surrey Senior Cup were Reigate Priory who were victorious six times before the end of the century.

Priory also made an excursion into European Football in 1910 where they won the International Cup de Nord beating Cercle Athletique Paris 3-0 in the final.

The Reigate Priory Veterans continue to expand it's youth section and will be represented by over 50 Youth Teams from as young as 9 to as old as 18.. The junior teams have fed the men's teams with many of our exciting young players. The Youth Section have also been awarded FA Charter Standard status.

Reigate Priory continues to develop with an increasing number of teams for the new season, enabling the club to provide an extended football experience catering for a variety of levels.
