# SCOTT BARTLETT'S EASTLEIGH SIDE EARNED A 1-1 DRAW AGAINST SCUNTHORPE UNITED ON TUESDAY NIGHT AT THE SILVERLAKE STADIUM.

Scunthorpe had the first chance of the game inside one minute, as the ball bounced to the feet of Scunthorpe defender Andrew Boyce from 25 yards out. The defender connected well with the ball but his half volley went just over the bar.

Just three minutes later, Scunthorpe were through on goal, with Carlton Ubaezuono being played through one on one with goalkeeper Nick Townsend, who got down low and kept out the Scunthorpe attackers left footed shot

Eastleigh had their first real chance of the game just after ten minutes, with Josh Lundstram receiving the ball down the right hand side, where he delivered a ball across the face of the Scunthorpe goal, but Harvey Saunders couldn't quite get onto the end of the ball despite his outstretched leg.

Scunthorpe went up the other end immediately, with a scramble in the penalty area finally landing at Joe Rowley's feet, but his left footed effort blazed straight over the bar.





Just five minutes into the second half, Scunthorpe were awarded a penalty, after a scramble from a corner saw Jean Belehouan be pushed into the net, and the referee deemed there to be enough in order to point to the spot, booking Luis Fernandez in the process.

Danny Whitehall stepped up to take the penalty, and slotted into the bottom right, sending Townsend the wrong way, giving Scunthorpe the lead.

Rowley would then get another big chance six minutes later, with his shot from the left hand side a strong one, but Townsend parried the shot out for the corner.



Eastleigh would get their first chance in the 62nd minute, with some well worked play from Archie Harris down the left hand side resulting in the ball falling to Jake Taylor who slipped through Ciaran McGuckin on the left hand side, with his shot from a tight angle pushed out for a corner.

Just a minute later, Alfie Beestin is played by Ubaezuonu through on goal, but Beestin's effort is poor, and Townsend got down low to produce a big save.

Eastleigh applied pressure throughout the second half, and in the 76th minute they would get their reward. Luke Skinner off the bench would cut inside from the right hand side, with his low driven left footed shot

fired just wide of the Scunthorpe goal.

A minute later, Scott Bartlett's side got their goal, after a long ball from Jake Taylor resulted in the second ball landing to the feet of Kieron Evans, who dribbled through before faking the shot twice, and eventually laying Skinner off on the right hand side, who played a left footed ball first time into the penalty area. McGuckin would be on the end of the pass inside the six yard box, who produced a sublime back heel flick towards goal, beating Rory Watson in goal.

The final 13 minutes were cagey, with neither side producing a big chance, ending the game in a 1-1 draw.

# Having played for Scott Bartlett before, how happy were you when you heard he was going to become Eastleigh manager?

I had some really good experiences when I did it myself, and I played with some great players. Hopefully Archie can do the same now, and kick on another level and make it to the mens team.

# You are one appearance away from making your 50th for Eastleigh, how proud are you of that?

Funnily enough, me and my dad were speaking about that after the Scunthorpe game. We were saying that I must be close to around 50 games. It's mad how quick time flies by. It feels like only a few weeks ago I was moving down here. It has all gone really well, and I have really enjoyed my time here. Hopefully, I can get at least another 50 more appearances here.

### A lot of those appearances came playing next to Ludwig Francillette, who is now at Morecambe. Are you looking forward to coming up against your former teammate?

Yeah, it will be nice to see him. He was brilliant for us last season, both defensively and he was able to get a few goals as well. That will be something that we will have to look out for. He is a massive threat in both boxes.





# Finally, what are your goals for the remainder of the season?

The most important one for me is to stay fit, and play as much as I can, following that little injury scare that I had. Apart from that, it is just to win as many games as we can, and hopefully implement the new style of football, and put on performances that the fans will want to see.



Morecambe will make a 538 mile round trip to visit the Silverlake Stadium for this afternoon's league clash.

The Shrimps play their home games at the Mazuma Mobile Stadium, which has housed them since 2010.

The ground has a maximum capacity of 6,476. Morecambe's record attendance there came in 2022, when 5,831 spectators watched them take on Sunderland in League One.

Before their move to the Mazuma Mobile Stadium, the Shrimps played their home matches at Christie Park. The ground on Lancaster Road housed them between 1921, until it was demolished in 2010.

Between 2021-2023, Morecambe played their football in League One, which is the highest level the club has played at. Following this, they spent two seasons in League Two, before being relegated to the National League.

Morecambe were last in the National League in the 2006/07 season, when they earned promotion through the play-offs.

Former Spitfire, Ludwig Francillette now plies his trade for the Shrimps, after making 86 appearances in Eastleigh colours.

During the 2024/25 season, the defender racked up a tally of eight goals for the Spitfires.



## **WALKING FOOTBALL**



#### OCTOBER SO FAR HAS BEEN A BUSY MONTH FOR EASTLEIGH'S WALKING FOOTBALL CLUB IN TOURNAMENTS

Earlier in the month the male over 70's played in the Hampshire League, losing one, winning one and drawing a  $3^{rd}$  game.

The following week the over 50's headed down to Hamworthy to compete in the Dorset League, in the opening round of this season's fixtures.

They drew 1-1 with Sherborne and with Dexters (Poole) and triumphed 2-0 over Bournemouth.

After that first round of matches, Eastleigh sit 4<sup>th</sup> in the table which comprises 10 teams. Next month they take on leaders Amesbury. Dorchester and Verwood.

As has been reported previously, the ladies tumbled out of the FA National Cup at the regional round but have started strongly in the Hampshire League.

As we go to press, the men are off to Hamworthy again, for the over 65's Dorset League. Report will be in the next programme notes.
