Founded in 1922 as the London & District Combination Football League, and renamed the Combined Counties Football League in 1978, the 2024–25 Cherry Red Combined CCL season will be the 47th in the history of the league. The league consists of four divisions for the second time, with a new Division Two being added to the Premier North, the Premier South and Division One. Division Two is intended largely for reserve and U23 sides, although it is also open to first teams.

Welcome to Horley Town

Founded in 1896 as Horley Football Club, the club first affiliated to the Surrey County Football Association that year. From the outset the club became a focal point for the local community in Horley, Surrey.

In 1903 a neighbouring club, Gatwick Rovers, was formed; the two clubs merged in 1908 under the Horley name. In their earliest years the colours were red and black, but by 1912 the club adopted the claret & blue colours which remain proudly worn today.

During the inter-war years Horley made steady progress. After reaching the Surrey County Junior Cup Final in 1923-24, the club captured the Surrey Junior Charity Cup in 1924-25 and soon the club entered the Surrey Intermediate League. The 1926-27 season saw the club crowned League Champions, marking the first major piece of silverware in the club's history.

After the Second World War, the club faced the challenge of securing a proper permanent home. Generous local benefactor Major A.L.N. Jennings gifted 10.7 acres of land in Smallfield Road; in 1947 the club moved to this ground, which was named "The Defence" in honour of those who fell in defence of the realm. In 1950-51 the club won the Eastern Section of the Surrey Intermediate League and were admitted to the Surrey Senior League for the 1951-52 season. However, this senior spell proved difficult, and by 1954-55 the club found itself back in junior football. In 1956 the club regained intermediate status, and by 1957-58 it had expanded into youth football, entering its first youth side in the Redhill & District League.

The 1970s brought the club its finest period. With the village of Horley growing into a town, the club formally changed its name in 1974 to Horley Town Football Club. In the 1976-77 campaign the club crowned a superb league and cup double, lifting the Surrey Senior League title and the League Cup. At the same time it reached the Surrey Senior League Charity Cup final, further underlining its position as a strong force in local senior football.

Following this era of success, the club accepted the challenge of broader competition. In 1978 Horley Town joined the Premier Division of the London Spartan League. After three seasons in Spartan competition the club entered the Athenian League in 1981-82. When the Athenian League disbanded at the end of the 1983-84 season the club transferred to the Combined Counties League (formerly the Home Counties League), where it would become a longstanding pillar.

In the mid-1990s the club hit a low point: after finishing bottom of the Combined Counties League in 1995-96 the club dropped into the Crawley & District League. However, in 2002 the club joined the Surrey County Senior League and in 2003 gained promotion to the Combined Counties League Premier Division. In 2006 ground-grading issues meant relegation to Division One, but a strong response saw the club finish as Division One runners-up in 2006-07 and promptly regain Premier Division status.

Welcome to Horley Town

A further major milestone arrived in September 2003 when the club moved into its current home, "The New Defence", located behind Horley Leisure Centre and Court Lodge Road. The modern facility sits on the same sporting footprint as the club's historic ground and reflects the club's ambition as a well-established community hub.

The early 2010s saw further evolution: the club emphasised its community role and youth development arms, embedding itself firmly as a "club for all ages" in Horley and the surrounding area. With resilience on the pitch, the club recorded strong league finishes and mounted promising cup runs. In 2017-18 the club reached the Fourth Round of the FA Vase for the first time in its history—a testament to the progress built over decades.

In recent years, while navigating the shifting landscapes of non-league football, the club has remained a constant presence in the Combined Counties League Premier Division (or equivalent lateral transfers) and continues to compete strongly both on and off the pitch. The present day sees Horley Town FC combining competitive senior football, a dynamic youth structure and strong links with the local community.

From its humble origins over 125 years ago to now, Horley Town has grown with the town of Horley, adopting a tradition of sporting pride, community engagement and stability. As the club looks ahead, it remains anchored by its motto of serving Horley and the surrounding area—fielding teams, providing facilities and inspiring youngsters—while fiercely preserving the colours, name and spirit that have defined the Clarets for well over a century

Player to Watch: Cameron Gyeabour

Cameron Gyeabour has quickly become one of Horley Town's most exciting attacking players and a constant threat for opposition defences. Known for his explosive pace and powerful running, he gives the Clarets a direct edge whenever he's on the pitch. Cameron is at his best driving forward with the ball, taking on defenders and turning tight situations into goal-scoring chances.

His movement off the ball is just as important. Always scanning for space, he times his runs well and stretches backlines, creating openings for teammates and giving Horley a valuable outlet during transitions. That blend of speed, strength and awareness makes him a key figure in the team's attacking identity.

Gyeabour's work rate is another standout trait. He presses tirelessly, forces mistakes, and sets the tone from the front. Still developing and improving with every match, he has the potential to become one of the league's standout forwards.

For supporters looking for energy, excitement and unpredictability, Cameron Gyeabour is definitely the player to watch this season.

Round up from the Combined Counties League

Let me begin by looking at the other matches in our division that took place on Saturday after our home game against Badshot Lea which was abandoned by the match officials at half time. Cobham increased their lead at the top of the table as some of the chasing clubs dropped points or did not have a game apart from Tooting & Mitcham who bounced back from their humbling 5-0 defeat on the previous Tuesday to in form Knaphill by winning at bottom of the table Guildford City 4-1. What of in form Knaphill? They surprisingly lost at home 2-1 to lowly Thatcham Town. With some teams not playing it gave some of the clubs outside the play off positions time to catch up as there are only 7 points separating 6th place and 13th place. The main mover was Corinthian Casuals who beat Fleet Town 2-0 which was a fine result considering they played a vast majority of the game with ten men; Fleet have not had a good couple of weeks, but I am sure they will bounce back soon enough. Ground Regulations 2025-26



Spectator Code of Conduct

All spectators attending home matches are required to read and comply with this Code of Conduct, and to respect the same principles when attending our away fixtures at other clubs. Entry to the Ground shall constitute acceptance of this Code of Conduct, the rules and regulations of The Football Association and The Combined Counties League. The Club reserves the right to amend, alter or update this Code of Conduct and to eject, ban or prosecute as appropriate or necessary at their sole discretion. Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and, in extreme cases, heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the Ground

If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late at night, and do not litter the area. Do not attempt to bring flares, fireworks or any other dangerous items into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and confiscate any prohibited items found. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. Do not attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground, or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the Ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Do not obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Do not stand in seating areas or block access gangways or steps. Do not behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and do not bring the Club into disrepute.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban: being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving antisocially; threatening behaviour; use of obscene or abusive language; persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures; racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment; fighting; entering the field of play before, during or after the game; throwing any missile or object onto the field of play; and setting off any flare or firework.

Strictly Forbidden

The following are strictly forbidden and may result in immediate eviction and a ban for repeat offenders: the consumption of alcohol in bottles, cans or glasses in the stands, terraces and other open areas within the ground; climbing onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure; obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes; playing ball games in areas populated by ground visitors; only service animals are permitted at Chalky Lane and must be kept on a leash. Vehicles must ensure they do not block emergency vehicle access.

The length of any ban imposed will be related to the severity of the offence and solely at the discretion of the Club. Any appeal may be made in writing through the Club Secretary and will be given full and due consideration.
