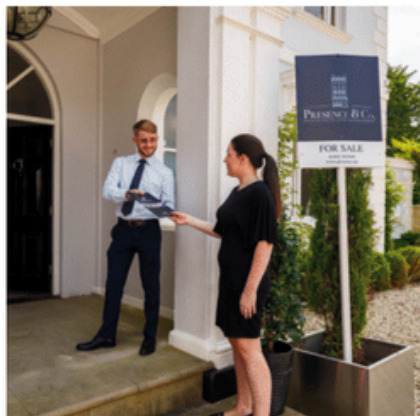

## SHEPPEY SPORTS

Originally founded in 1919 and established as a senior club in 1946. The club has been a long time force in the Kent leagues and has a very proud history.

The present club reformed in 1974 and as reeds international won the western Premier in 1987/88 and again in 1990/91 after reverting to APM, in 2009 the Contrast name was added as local business man Dave Dadson of Contrast South East put in a big sponsorship deal.

The Club played its football at K Sports, Cobdown, where we had a long standing history. The football club has always been a senior section but in 2013-2014 season APM grow with the introduction of a youth section with two teams in the Kent Youth League. The next season saw the club has now grown even further with the amalgamation of Holtwood Rangers and a full youth section was introduced making the club a force in Kent Football.

The 2017-18 Season saw Kris Browning's side finish in second place in the First Division, just missing out on the title to Punjab United. It was good enough for promotion though the 2018-19 campaign saw K Sports take their place in the SCEFL Premier Division where they finished in an impressive 12th place.

The 2019/20 and 2020/21 seasons were made null and void due to the Coronavirus Pandemic before a 17th place finish was the result in the 2021/22 campaign.

The 2022/23 season resulted in relegation to the SCEFL First Division where a 13th placed finish was gained the following year.

## A SHORT HISTORY

AFC Greenwich Borough was officially launched in 2025, built on the foundations of Welling United FC Academy. Over seven years, the academy became known for its commitment to youth development, community programmes, and a professional environment that prepared players for the next level.

The transition to AFC Greenwich Borough marked the start of a new era. Not as a rebrand or phoenix club, but a bold step forward. The club now fields senior men's, women's, and vets teams, alongside more than 50 youth teams, and is recognised as one of the largest footballing structures in Southeast London.

Since 2023, the club has achieved 12 league titles, reached 34 cup finals, won 22 cups, and helped over 50 players into the professional game.

Our partnership with GB10 Sports Hub provides top-class pitches, classrooms, scholarship opportunities, gym access, and recovery facilities; everything a player needs to develop. GB10 is our hub. It brings our players, coaches, and teams together under one roof, enabling stronger communication, better development, and a real sense of belonging.

The club's reach spans the Southern Counties East Football League, Southern Veterans Football League, and London & South East Regional Women's Football League, with home bases at GB10 and the RTL Group Stadium.

Following their launch in 2023, Greenwich Borough Men's Vets First Team were crowned 2024-25 SVFL Championship winners and will compete in the Premier Division next season. They also lifted the Beckenham Hospital Cup, defeating several Premier Division teams along the way.

Our Women's First Team compete in the L&SERWFL and finished a strong fourth place in the 2024-25 season. With a clear vision and exciting talent, we look forward to even greater success under the Greenwich Borough name.
