Getting to the ground by Public transport




The nearest train station to Jenner Park is Cadoxton Train Station which is a short 20-minute walk according to google maps. The station also benefits from disabled access and lifts. This route takes you along Vere street, up Main Street before following Barry Road to the ground. This is a fairly flat route.

M4 Junction 37 Pyle to J38 Margam

Work to carry out essential bridge maintenance to five structures on the M4 between J37 and J38 currently taking place with contraflow system in place and traffic flow reduced from three lanes to two lanes in both directions. A 50-mph speed limit is in place for safety. Expect delays.
