Woking 8-0 Lingfield

Woking prepared for this fixture with a team largely made up of Academy players, joined by Ross, Ward, Effiong and Osude from the First team squad. Lingfield are currently in the bottom three of the Southern Combination Premier and their struggles as a Step 5 club were to continue against the Cards.

The hosts led after five minutes, Osude intercepting a pass, driving into the penalty area and finishing neatly into the bottom corner. Woking controlled possession, Patterson and Boxall dominant in midfield, while Rangel and Wilson built calmly from the back. Cotton and Parkes supported attacks well, the former making a strong covering tackle to stop a rare Lingfield break.

The second came on 35 minutes when Cotton and Ward combined to set up Boxall, and Osude fired home the rebound. Effiong then went close before another Patterson pass released Osude, whose shot was parried into the path of Dryer to make it three before the break.

Half-time: Woking 3-0 Lingfield

The pressure continued, Ross briefly tested by a free kick that clipped the outside of the post.

Effiong made it four on 55 minutes, forcing an error from the goalkeeper and calmly finishing from the left edge of the box. Dryer soon added a fifth, robbing a defender wide left before cutting inside and striking low beyond the keeper.

Ward scored the sixth after combining with Osude, turning his marker and finishing from close range. Patterson then went close from 25 yards before Osude completed his hat-trick from the penalty spot after Ward was fouled.

Substitutes Verga, Hayati, Trickett, Christophers and Jennison-Leppa were all introduced, the latter two Academy second years. Patterson completed the scoring on 75 minutes, winning the ball in midfield, exchanging a one-two with Hayati and slotting confidently past the keeper.

Woking remained composed to keep the clean sheet, Wilson making a key tackle, while Dryer was denied a hat-trick late on. The Cards will now host Cobham in Round Two, another Step 5 side and current leaders of the Combined Counties Premier Division South.

WOKING HISTORY

BONFIRE NIGHT GETS OFF TO AN EXPLOSIVE START

The Cardinal Tales by Mark Doyle

Saturday 5 November 1887
Inaugural Friendly Fixture
Woking 6 Chertsey 1
Attendance on the Wheatsheaf
Common: Unknown

Today we celebrate the one hundredth and thirty-eighth anniversary of our football club. The Woking Football Club can trace its humble beginnings back to an advertisement in the local press for a meeting which took place on Wednesday 26 October 1887 at The Railway Hotel on Guildford Road Woking (now The Sovereigns pub) to elect officials and arrange local friendly fixtures. Training was arranged to take place every Wednesday on the playing field behind The Railway Hotel and their historic first friendly match,

against Chertsey, took place on Wheatsheaf Common on 5 November 1887. The players were asked to provide their own towel on the day, changed for the game in the Wheatsheaf Hotel whilst drawing water from the Hotel well to bathe. Although the visitors scored first, the result was a convincing win for the home team and a certain Mr William Railton is credited as scoring the first ever goal for Woking Football Club. Although it's beyond doubt that Woking won their inaugural tie, the score was in fact recorded as 6-2 and 3-1 in a couple of local newspapers, this was not an unusual occurrence at the time, as the lack of goal nets, crossbars and the fact that the point could only be awarded by the umpire if the scoring side claimed the goal didn't help matters. This inaugural victory over Chertsey

was to be somewhat of a false dawn though, as Woking proceeded to be defeated in their next four recorded games, conceding twenty goals for no reply.

Originally nicknamed "the Cremators", which was a reference to the United Kingdom's first ever crematorium in St. Johns which held its first human cremation in March 1885, the club initially played in cardinal and white stripes. Another quirky nickname for the club at the time was "The Ites", which was an abbreviation of "Woking-ites" and was a reference to both the club and their supporters. The fledgling Woking club played just bespoke friendlies until joining the West Surrey League in 1895/96, by which time they had adopted their now famous cardinal and white halved shirts. The distinguished gentleman pictured seated in the suit is Herbert William Robertson who played in Woking's very first match against Chertsey in 1887. Born in Brixton in 1871, founding member "Bert" played forty-one times for the Cremators, becoming club captain and eventually club secretary in 1893. He worked as a railway accounts clerk and lived in Board School Road, Boundary Road Maybury and then Maybury Hill from 1911.

No one seemed to know for sure why 1889 appeared over 1887 as the "Officially Founded" date of the club on much printed material. Woking certainly played its first game on that autumnal November afternoon against Chertsey (although one newspaper report had the team's title down as "Woking Station"). There's written confirmation from early newspaper reports and early Woking FC yearbooks which directly related back to 1887 as being our founding date. In addition, newspaper reports at the time of the Cremators famous F.A Cup First Round encounter with the mighty Bolton Wanderers in 1908 repeat the line "the most momentous event in Woking FC's twenty-one-year history". The first printed confirmation of "Founded in 1889" that I can find is in the early 1920s. A plausible theory for this error is that 1889 was the first year that there was a printed football fixture card. There again it could be as simple as a club official making an error with their mental arithmetic when the club started playing again after the Great War in 1919 – I guess we will never know for sure, but the anomaly has now thankfully been rectified and appears proudly on the new club badge.

ABOUT

An initiative to help the Club's playing budget with regular contributions. More than £200,000 has gone to the Club throughout the scheme.

The Cards Trust arranges coach travel to away matches for supporters at the lowest cost possible. If you are an advertiser that would like to sponsor the travel, please get in touch.

Details of all coaches are available on the Trust website, where tickets can be booked online, usually up to 23:00 on the day before the match. Members and Junior Cards get discounted away match travel.

SUPPORTERS' LIAISON GROUP

The SLG consults with fans (both Trust members and non-members) and the Club to improve the fan experience. Real change has been made based on ideas from the group including the successful Turner's Tannoy appeal which has financed the recent upgrade in the PA at the stadium.

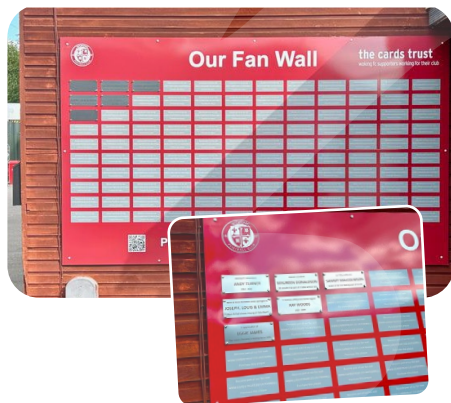

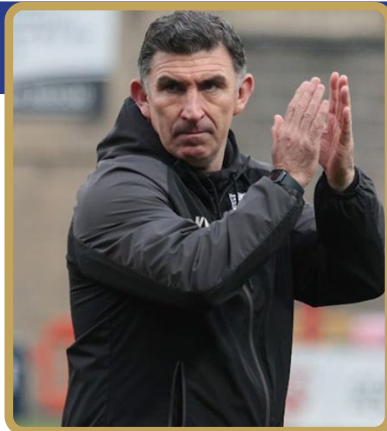

MEET THE BOSS

Kevin Maher

Kevin Maher returned to Southend United as Head Coach in October 2021, having twice captained the club to promotion in 450 games. A former Tottenham Hotspur Academy graduate, he became a key figure at Roots Hall, leading Blues to back-to-back promotions under Steve Tilson. After spells with Gillingham, Oldham, and Dagenham, he coached at Chelmsford City and Bristol Rovers before returning home. As of October 2025, Maher has managed 204 games, winning 88 and drawing 5, a 43% win rate.



ONE TO WATCH

Ben Goodliffe

Joining Southend United on loan from Colchester United for the 2024/25 season, Ben Goodliffe arrived with over 200 senior appearances before turning 25. A former Tottenham Hotspur trainee, he joined Wolverhampton Wanderers at 18 after breaking through at Boreham Wood. He gained experience with Wolves' Under-21s and on loan at Dagenham & Redbridge before signing for Sutton United, where he made 182 appearances and helped win promotion to League Two in 2020/21. After Sutton's relegation, he joined Colchester, making 14 appearances before moving to the Shrimpers.

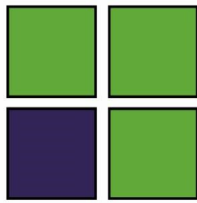


ONE TO WATCH

On 8 July 2024, striker Josh Walker signed for the Blues on a two-year deal. 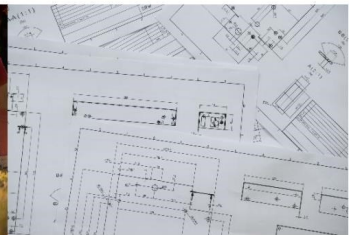

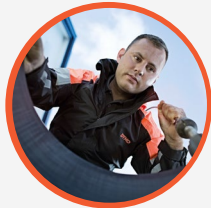
