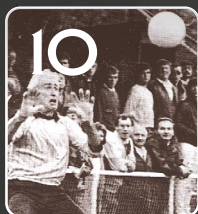

Woking claimed back-to-back away league wins, thanks to strikes from Ashley Boatswain, Jack Turner and Josh Kelly.

After the disaster midweek against Brackley, a big result was needed from the long journey to Cheshire. After a positive few days in training, Neal Ardley's side came out with a strong message as Boatswain fired home his second goal in his first three games.

The hosts managed to get back on level terms when they split the Woking defence, and Jimmy Knowles was the spare man in the box to skillfully beat Will Jaaskelainen.

Shortly before half-time, however, Jack Turner spun his defender in the box and fired home past Fallon in goal to regain our advantage at the break.

### Half time: Altrincham 1-2 Woking

Alty never really troubled the Cards in the second half, and Kelly made them pay in the final few moments after winning a penalty and coolly converted from 12 yards to send the 96 travelling supporters into a frenzy.

A great performance on the day was the perfect way to bounce back and gain confidence going into our next league game against table toppers Rochdale AFC.

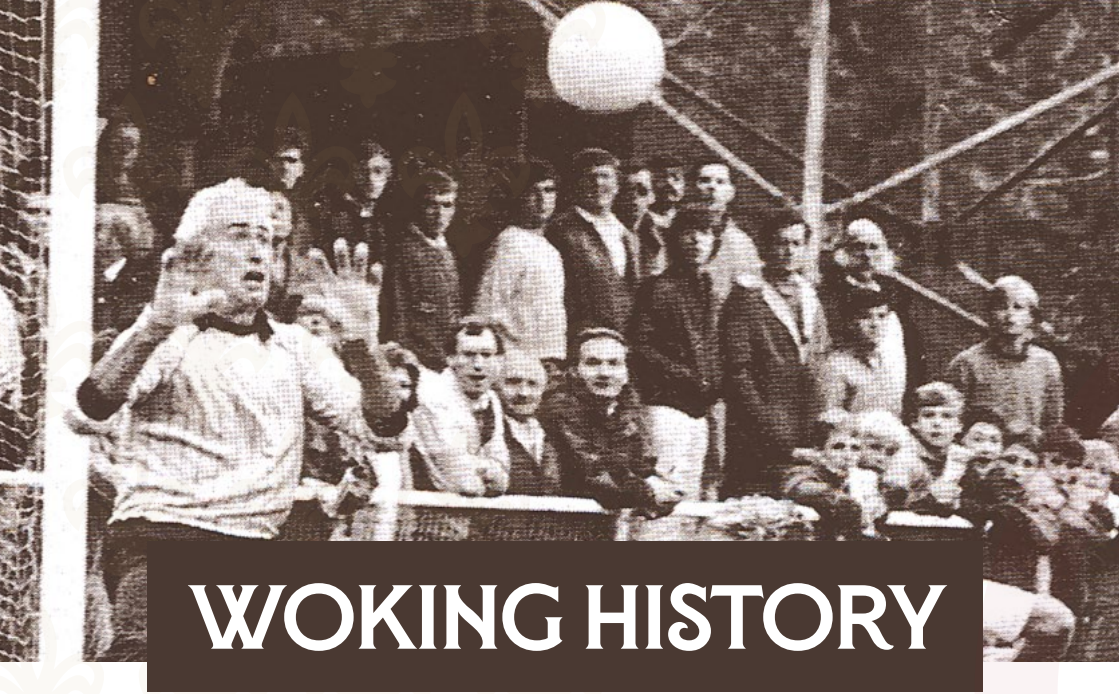

# WOKING HISTORY

## The Year Of The Cat

The Cardinal Tales by Mark Doyle

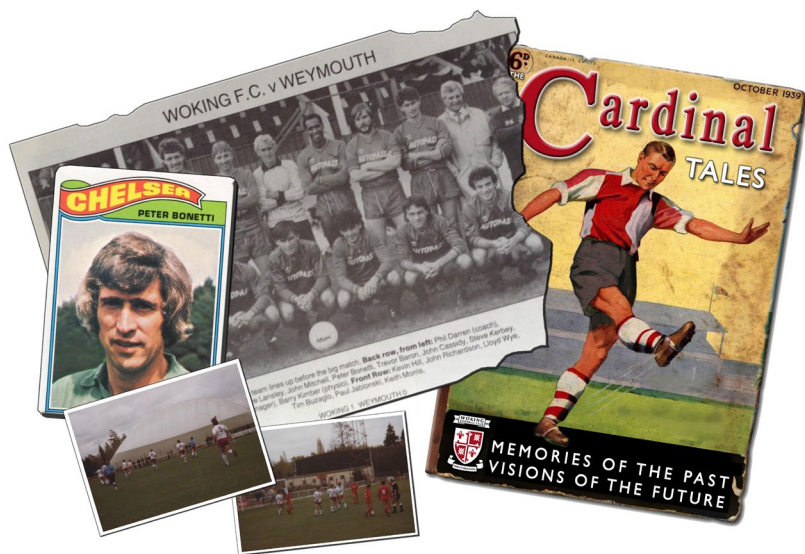
**Saturday 25 October 1986**  
**F.A Cup 4th Qualifying Round**  
**Woking 1 Weymouth 0**  
**Attendance: 1,029**

**T**hirty-nine years ago today, an excitable Kingfield crowd were treated to a fine game and brilliant giant-killing performance from Isthmian League Division Two South Woking, with a young Tim Buzaglo and Trevor Baron showing up particularly well for the men clad in their all-red Autopass kit. This fixture was still a good three years before David Hasselhoff heroically managed to bring down the Berlin Wall; consequently due to his Cold War commitments Woking's goalkeeper Lance Corporal Chris Lomas was unavailable to play in this F.A Cup tie. So the Cardinals found themselves with the unexpected sight of forty-five year-old former Chelsea and

England goalkeeper Peter Phillip Bonetti in between the sticks for their most important game for five seasons.

Stand-in Woking custodian Peter Bonetti made his Chelsea debut at the age of just eighteen in March 1960 - inevitably keeping a clean sheet - the first of two hundred and eight for the Blues. Bonetti was a Stamford Bridge legend, nicknamed "The Cat" for his astonishing reflexes and graceful agility. He made seven hundred and twenty-nine appearances for the Blues, making him the second highest appearance maker in their history; only Ron "Chopper" Harris has made more. Bonetti initially left Chelsea in 1975 to move to the United States of America to play for the St Louis Stars, but returned within a year, Chelsea found his experience crucial as a young and inexperienced Eddie McCreadie





Chelsea team battled to promotion back to Division One in 1977. Two years later Peter retired to the Isle of Mull in Scotland where he became a Postman. He did however have a brief five game spell at Dundee United before being persuaded by Woking manager Geoff Chapple to play for the Cards whilst he was a goal-keeping coach at Stamford Bridge.

In the opening stages of this Cup tie the three Division's gap between the two combatants was vividly clear, had Bonetti not reacted superbly to keep out a Colin Chester close range header in only the fourth minute and then sixty seconds later got down well to save a Tom Jones drive (yes, the same Tom Jones who was destined to return to Kingfield a decade later, not the Welsh crooner of the same name) the story would have almost certainly have been very different, but the Cards gradually fought their way into the game for a fairly even first half. After the re-start the Terras again saw most of the ball but never troubled Peter "The Cat" Bonetti in the Woking goal. Then on seventy-four minutes Woking got the breakthrough they deserved when Mark Dawber, cutting in from

the right, left two defenders in his wake and hit a superb shot from twenty yards, giving the Weymouth keeper no chance and sending the crowd standing under the old concrete "Bus Stop", situated where the imposing Leslie Gosden Stand is today wild with delight. Woking - three divisions below Weymouth - were unlucky not to add a second goal soon after and fully deserved to reach their first First Round tie since the great Barnet and Swansea City FA Cup run of the 1978/79 season, this time against Southern League table toppers and current Conference South comrades Chelmsford City.

With only two appearances in a Woking shirt on his curriculum vitae, Peter Bonetti finally hung up his playing boots for the very last time after the Cardinals 1-2 Isthmian League defeat at Marlow on Tuesday 28th October 1986. Woking's reserves beat Kingstonian at Richmond Road on the same day that Bonetti was gracing Kingfield, the only goal coming in the 79th minute when an Adie Cowler free kick was dropped by the Ks keeper and steered home by "stocky" young forward, Clive Youton, for his ninth reserve team goal of the season.

The shop is also open Mon – Fri, 10:00 – 16:00, upon check-in at reception.

## **ABOUT**

The Cards Trust (Cardinals Supporters Society) has worked with the Club to represent fans for more than a decade. The Trust is a shareholder of the Club (and owns around a quarter of it) and has a representative on the Board to put forward the fans' views.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

Supporters can join The Cards Trust for just £10 per year. Information about joining is on the Trust website.

## **BOOST THE BUDGET**

An initiative to help the Club's playing budget with regular contributions. More than £200,000 has gone to the Club throughout the scheme.

## **THE 400 CLUB**

A prize draw with twelve draws per year. Around £20,000 has been given to support the Club and more than £12,000 in prizes.

## **GOLDRUSH**

The prize draw that gives back 50% to the lucky winner with a draw at half-time on matchday, with a minimum stake of just £1. The prizes have recently been around £400 and the winning number is announced and displayed on the digital screen at half-time.

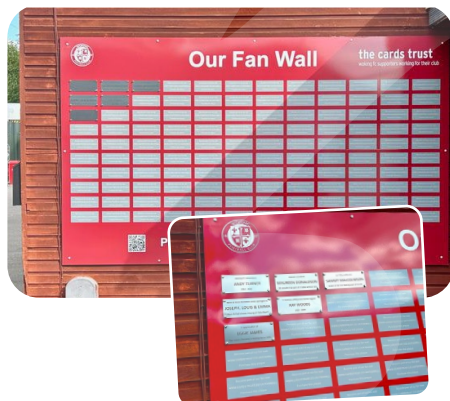

The 6ft 5in striker began at Sheffield Wednesday in 2013, with loans to Hyde, Fleetwood and Chesterfield before a permanent move to the Spireites. Spells at Kidderminster, Salford (where he won back-to-back promotions), Tranmere, Grimsby, Halifax and Hartlepool followed, earning a reputation as a powerful forward and proven goalscorer.
