


# TODAY'S OPPOSITION

## RECENT CLUB HISTORY

The management partnership of Neil Baker and Jon Underwood are in their tenth with the club and fifth season in the Vanarama National League South. In their first term back in 2014, Slough Town won the play-offs the hard way, to win promotion to the Southern League Premier Division. Two seasons of consolidation followed and 2016/17 saw Slough make a play-off place losing out to Leamington. A very strong run-in from Slough the following year saw the Rebels finish in third place to earn a play-off place. Ironically, they beat Kettering in the semi-final, the same team defeated in the 2014 play-off final, and a tremendous fight back at King's Lynn saw Slough win promotion again by 2-1. Slough had regained their position in the National League after 20 years. The circumstances of which still rankles with some supporters. In the first term in the National South division, Slough missed out on a play-off place by 2 points. The doors on football were shut by Covid in March. However, in the points per game in the second season at this level saw Slough finish in fifth place to earn a play-off place and a chance into the Premier Division of the National League. In the event behind closed doors, the Rebels were well beaten by Dartford at Arbour Park. The adventure continues tentatively amid the dark impact of Covid. What that means is far from certain and starting the season is tentative.

Slough have found the National League South tougher and the score margins are much closer. Most teams are capable of beating everyone else in this Division, so it is fine margins. As before Slough had a solid start to the season, tailing off in the New Year. The FA Cup was a little disappointing having had a good win at Flackwell Heath, Slough bowed out in a replay at home to Chippenham. In the first match Slough went 1-0 down only to rally to a 2-1 lead. The bluebirds then came back to 3-2 before a stoppage time equaliser from Bird. Slough almost had time for a winner but the whistle blew. In the replay, the visitors always seemed more determined and went 1-0 up before Slough levelled. Chippenham went ahead again before another leveller from the home side. But Chippenham stuck at it and Chambers scored the last goal, so 11 goals in this cup tie. It was a similar tale with the FA Trophy, drawing away to Concord Rangers but losing the replay at home. The Senior Cup win over MK Dons gave high hopes of retaining the oldest County cup but the competition was abandoned because of the emergency.

The last two seasons will long be remembered for the epic FA Cup runs. In 2017 reaching the Second Round was the equivalent of a Premier League club reaching the Final. Promotion did mean that Slough had one less round to play to reach the Second Round again in 2018. Probably Slough had the hardest task in 2017, starting at Berkhamsted winning 3-1, they defeated Dulwich 3-2 at home, Poole 2-1 at home, Folkestone 1-0 at home before winning 6-0 in Lincolnshire at Gainsborough. Once Rochdale scored their first goal at Arbour Park, the result was not really in doubt.

Slough started the FA Cup trail slowly last term with a 2-2 home draw with Sholing, winning the replay 3-0. Bristol Manor Farm were the visitors in the next round and they also secured a replay with a 2-2 draw. This time, Slough won the replay 4-0, and fans for both clubs enjoyed the occasion. Fellow league opponents were next for Slough with a visit to Eastbourne Borough, Slough winning 2-1. This set Slough up for a tough visit to National League Premier side Sutton United in the First Round. Arguably amongst the worst draws possible. Slough came away with a 0-0 draw, to set up a replay at Arbour Park. Harry Beautyman's 9th minute goal for long periods looked like it would settle it for the visitors, as Sutton piled on the pressure.

However, the longer the game went on, the more Slough gained the upper hand, and Dobson scored a deserved leveller on 81 minutes, so extra time. Although Slough had the better of it in extra time, no goals were scored. Slough had not done well in their last penalty shoot-outs in the FA Cup. This time they held their nerve and emerged winners by 8-7. The visit of Gillingham was almost an anti-climax setting an attendance record for Arbour Park of 2,084. Slough had the better of it in the first half and probably should have scored more than one goal. After the break, a lack of concentration saw Gillingham score in the 48th minute and despite Slough putting on the better show, they were unable to score. Slough now hold the record for reaching the Second Round of the FA Cup without progressing further.

Back in 2012/13 Slough had another spectacular FA Cup run, only losing to eventual Conference winners, Mansfield Town, on penalties after 210 minutes of closely fought football in the First Round. In 2004 Slough reached the Second Round by defeating Walsall 2-1 in the First Round, matching their success over Millwall in the 1980s.

During the last thirty years or so the Rebels have enjoyed reaching the FA Cup Proper Rounds regularly, playing Wycombe Wanderers, Romford, Brentford, Reading (twice), Hungerford Town, Yeovil Town, Millwall (local boy Gary Attrell living a few hundred metres from the Wexham Park ground scoring the winning goal), Bishop's Stortford, Cardiff City, Leyton Orient, Plymouth Argyle, Torquay Athletic, Macclesfield Town, Birmingham City, Swansea City, Macclesfield Town, Walsall (another local hero Glen Harris a schoolteacher netting the winner after Walsall levelled Ian Hodges' first), Mansfield Town, Yeading, Bromley and Harrogate Railway. The attendance for the Birmingham City game was 13,394, the second largest audience for Slough, after the Amateur Cup Final in 1973 that was estimated as 41,000.

Slough Town's origins have been taken as 1889, but a report in the Slough Observer records the first fixture being played sixteen years earlier in 1873 against Windsor Albion and documents their continuity to the present time. Slough were named as the Slows, before re-naming as Slough Rangers under the same leadership of Mr Sargeant the Club Secretary in 1876.

## KEY PLAYER PROFILES

### Defenders

#### GUY HOLLIS

Moved from Godalming in June 2013 with the managers and established himself at the heart of the Rebels defence ever since. Previously played for Ashford Town and Carshalton. Made his 200th appearance for the club in the promotion winning play off final at Kings Lynn in May 2018.

#### JOSH JACKMAN

Joined the club from March Town in the summer of 2016. Highly rated full back who is also comfortable in midfield and has put in a number of commanding performances on the right hand side of the pitch and will go past 50 appearances for Slough during the 2018/19 season.

#### GEORGE WELLS

A left-back who originally signed for the Rebels from Ryman League, Premier Division side Kingstonian in the summer of 2017. Joint managers Neil Baker and Jon Underwood have kept tabs on George since he made his debut for Hampton & Richmond Borough at a young age, and he has since developed into an excellent defender. Has also featured for neighbours Maidenhead United over a two year spell with the Berkshire side in the National League before returning to Slough in July 2022.

#### JOE DANDY

Defender who is comfortable in the centre or right hand side of defence. Signed from Bognor Regis Town in 2022. Versatile defensive player who was previously with Portsmouth and Finnish second division side Pallo-Lirot.

### Midfielders

#### AARON KUHLL

Signed for the Rebels in November 2019 after a spell at Basingstoke Town. He was a member of the Reading academy and played in the Championship for the Royals as an 18-year-old, at the time representing England at U19 and U20 level. Having recovered from a medial ligament injury, he dual signed for Slough having impressed in a friendly against Aldershot.

#### MATT LENCH

Re-joined the Rebels in January 2019 following short spell at Wealdstone. Matt is a highly sought after midfielder who initially joined the Rebels from Hitchin in the summer of 2017. Can play in a number of attacking positions and hit 16 goals in the 2016/17 campaign for Hitchin.

#### GEORGE HUNT

George moved to Slough Town after leaving EFL Championship club AFC Bournemouth. A Slough resident, George has a great pedigree from his time at professional clubs growing up, firstly spending two years at Coventry

City as a scholar, and more recently with AFC Bournemouth Under 23s where he also worked under former Weymouth manager Mark Molesley, who highly recommended him.

#### SCOTT DAVIES

Scott began his career as a professional at Reading and played around 100 games in the Football League, the majority of which were on loan in League One and League Two. He also made well over 100 appearances in the Conference South for Wealdstone, Oxford City and Chelmsford City. Now into his third spell with the Rebels, the popular midfielder will be looking to add to his 86 appearances.

#### JOHNNY GODDARD

Midfielder Johnny Goddard joined the club from St. Albans City in June 2022. Johnny began his career at Reading, progressing through the youth system before signing his first professional contract in 2011. Has also represented Hayes & Yeading and was a fans favourite at Woking with 25 goals in 116 appearances for the Cards, a spell which earned him a move to Swindon Town. Later played for Stevenage, Aldershot and Ebbsfleet before returning to Woking in 2020.

### Strikers

#### BEN HARRIS

Centre forward who joined Slough Town in December 2017 from Ascot United. Ben had been playing at Ascot to get his match fitness up after returning from playing in New Zealand for the previous two seasons, where he played for Team Wellington and Miramar Rangers in their top league, the New Zealand Football Championship. Prior to that, Ben was a big part of the Hampton & Richmond Borough team under Alan Dowson. Ben is a local lad, having been born in Slough and now lives in Windsor, where he started his football career as a 17-year-old.

#### ELLIOTT BENYON

Elliot Benyon joined the club from Oxford City in June 2022 having spent three successful seasons there. Will bring leadership skills to the changing room and on the pitch is a hard-working competitive player. Benyon began his career as a trainee at Bristol City and after loan spells at St Albans City and Crawley Town, signed for Torquay United where he made a substitute appearance at Wembley in their defeat to Ebbsfleet United in the 2008 FA Trophy Final.

#### IMRAN KAYANI

Has represented England independent schools at U17 and U18 level having come through the Chelsea Elite Academy. Featured prominently for Sutton United's academy before linking up with the Slough U23 side where he continued to impress and earned himself a place in the first team squad.

**Both sides had to settle for a draw as Worthing ended a wretched run with a point and Taunton Town took something back to Somerset.**

In the midst of an injury crisis - and already missing Captain Aarran Racine at the start of a three-match ban, after his red card at Braintree last week - Manager Adam Hinshelwood recalled Luca Cocoracchio from a temporary spell at Horsham for a National South and seasonal debut. Danny Barker and Lewis White joined a growing crocked list, while Sammie McLeod and Cal Kealy started on the bench. Recalls, therefore, went to Dan Bowry, Javaun Splatt, Moe Shubbar and Mo Jammeh, with Reece Myles-Meekums well once more for a replacement spot.

The hosts got off to a cracking start thanks to James Beresford winning a penalty, when he was tripped on the left hand side of the box by Ollie Chamberlain just three minutes in. Home debutant Iby Akanbi, surprisingly, stepped up to take it but fired a tame effort straight down the middle to give goalkeeper Jack Bycroft an easy save.

However, he soon made amends for that miss by bagging his maiden strike in a red shirt.

Jammeh's ball along the left flank found Ikanbi who held off visiting Skipper Nick Grimes, played a one-two with fellow forward Splatt and broke into the eighteen yard area to flick a low finish beyond the outstretched hand of Southampton loanee Bycroft.

He might have made it two before the midway point of the half, only to miss the target as Bycroft ventured outside his box a second time in quick succession, in a failed attempt at clearing the danger created by (Joe) Rye's range finder.

Nat Jarvis and Lee Lucas had half-chances for Town, with the former also heading wide via a blocked Dave Sims-Burgess shot before the man so good they named him three times set up the simplest of equalisers.

Taking a short pass from Chamberlain, Lloyd James looked up and located Sims-Burgess on the opposite side of the area to head home unmarked and level the score.

A long distance attempt by Chamberlain that landed comfortably in the hands of Harrison (Male) closed out an opening forty-five that gave both Bosses food for thought at the break.

The goalie's gloves were warmed once again, ten minutes after the turnaround when James nestled the ball in them from his free-kick.

Something Shubbar didn't do following a promising run that ended with an airborne attempt sailing over the top.

Crawley capture Shubbar came much closer - some time later - though by forcing Bycroft into a fine fingertip save, at the expense of a corner - as his deadball delivery, emanating from a foul on Ollie



Pearce a tiny fraction outside the eighteen yard box on the right, caused concern for the man in green. Foulston's free-kick did likewise for The Peacocks but any fears were quickly quashed due to an offside Grimes.

Shubbar continued to be a thorn in the side of both the guests on the pitch and the neighbours off it; a driving run through the centre of the pitch by Captain Kane (Wills) met with an off-target curler. Set-pieces were proving critical to Worthing's hopes of claiming a first win in six matches and Shubbar created a carbon copy of his earlier effort when Bycroft tipped it over the top, again.

Clearcut chances had been a fairly rare occurrence throughout a tight tussle between last term's Isthmian and Southern (South) League Champions, as evidenced by proceedings reaching the final few minutes and Pearce carving out one of the best of them.

Pearce's preciseness so nearly reaping rewards, thanks to a right wing cross that substitutes Kealy missed with an attempted header and the incoming, stretching Myles-Meekums performed a similar act with, although using his foot in this instance.

Agony may have turned to ecstasy in the fifth and final scheduled minute of stoppage time.

The recently introduced Adam Adam laid off to Shubbar at the culmination of some neat and well-worked approach play but, sadly, Moe couldn't keep his effort low enough to at least test Bycroft on one last occasion.

Humphrey then reversed roles slightly by slipping in Tibble who laid back to Worsfold to curl narrowly over the crossbar.

Less than a minute later, an unmarked Worsfold, on the right, allowed Bridge to drift inside and tempt Ella Newman to line up a low, driven effort that needed two attempts at gathering by Hamlet custodian Saskia Reeves-Priestley.

Dulwich enjoyed a profitable period on the left flank, particularly in the form of Madi Parsonson; the number two cutting in off it, evading the challenges of Bridge and Chloe Lelliott although, ultimately, drilling the wrong side of the near upright from long range.

However, the right couldn't be ruled out either, ably demonstrated by a burst of speed from Rebecca May that took her past Rachel Palmer and led to Russell coming across to get in a terrific, clean sliding tackle to stop the striker in her tracks, on the edge of the eighteen yard box.

That had occurred a few short moments after a bloody nose had forced the unfortunate Winchester to be withdrawn for Bell.

The early exchanges following the half-time interval saw few chances for either side in a tight encounter that might have gone either way.

Although, the recently-introduced Becs passed up a golden opportunity to break the deadlock when



Worsfold's right-sided delivery presented her with a sight of goal seven minutes into the second forty-five. Bell, who bagged a brace in the win at Woodside, flashing an attempt across the face of goal.

Newman and Bell then linked up with twenty to go to almost devastating effect.

A corner by the former headed over the top by the latter as the guests maintained their quest for success.

Not long afterwards, Ella Wales-Bonner had them singing in the Valleys, as well as on the terraces, thanks to a neat turn to get away from Lelliott and supply substitute Saskia Philip. The forward finding Manzi in the danger zone, where Dolbear ensured home frustrations continued.

Barely pausing for breath however, Bell searched for her inner giraffe in a desperately-close move emanating off the foot of Newman once more. A zipping cross just unable to be converted by the galloping gazelle.

BB's pace also ensured another close encounter, when she beat netminder Reeves-Priestley to the ball but fractionally failed to divert it on target.

Ten from the end and still with neither team having seized the initiative, Newman stepped up to try and take the points back to West Sussex.

Firstly, the grateful recipient of a Reeves-Priestley clearance, at a distance, that was rapidly returned with interest, though caught fairly comfortably by a relieved shot-stopper.

Secondly, some good hold-up play by Humphrey enabling Ella to go for glory a long way out and finish a short way wide, before a third and final attempt - the closest Dulwich or Worthing had come to pocketing the points - causing the top of the goal frame to shudder as the winger bounced one of the bar, twenty to twenty-five yards away from it.
